

Starting a fire – Loungeroom and Hall fireplaces only

Wood and kindling is located next to each fireplace. To replenish the boxes you will need to go to the wood shed which is located on the south side of the building as you exit the loungeroom to the verandah.

It is your responsibility to collect the firewood from the shed in a safe and appropriate manner.

Please leave the boxes full at the completion of your stay.

To light the fire: Use only dry wood and make sure the fireplace is emptied of ashes.

Step 1: Lay out the kindling in a cross pattern or pyramid on a spread of crunched newspaper



Step 2: Reverse air flow in the chimney by rolling a newspaper cone and lighting it like a torch. Hold it in the chimney for a minute. This creates an upward draft.



Step 3: Touch an ignited match to opposite ends of the newspaper. The kindling will ignite shortly. Fire lighters are provided for your convenience. Please note that the foil wrapped lighters do not need to be removed from their wrappers before lighting.



Step 4: Once the kindling catches, place larger pieces of wood lengthwise or crossed above the kindling. Add more wood as needed



Step 5: Enjoy!
